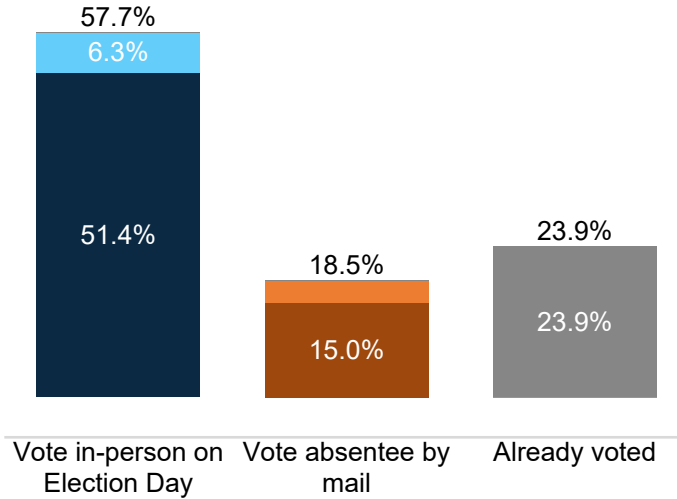

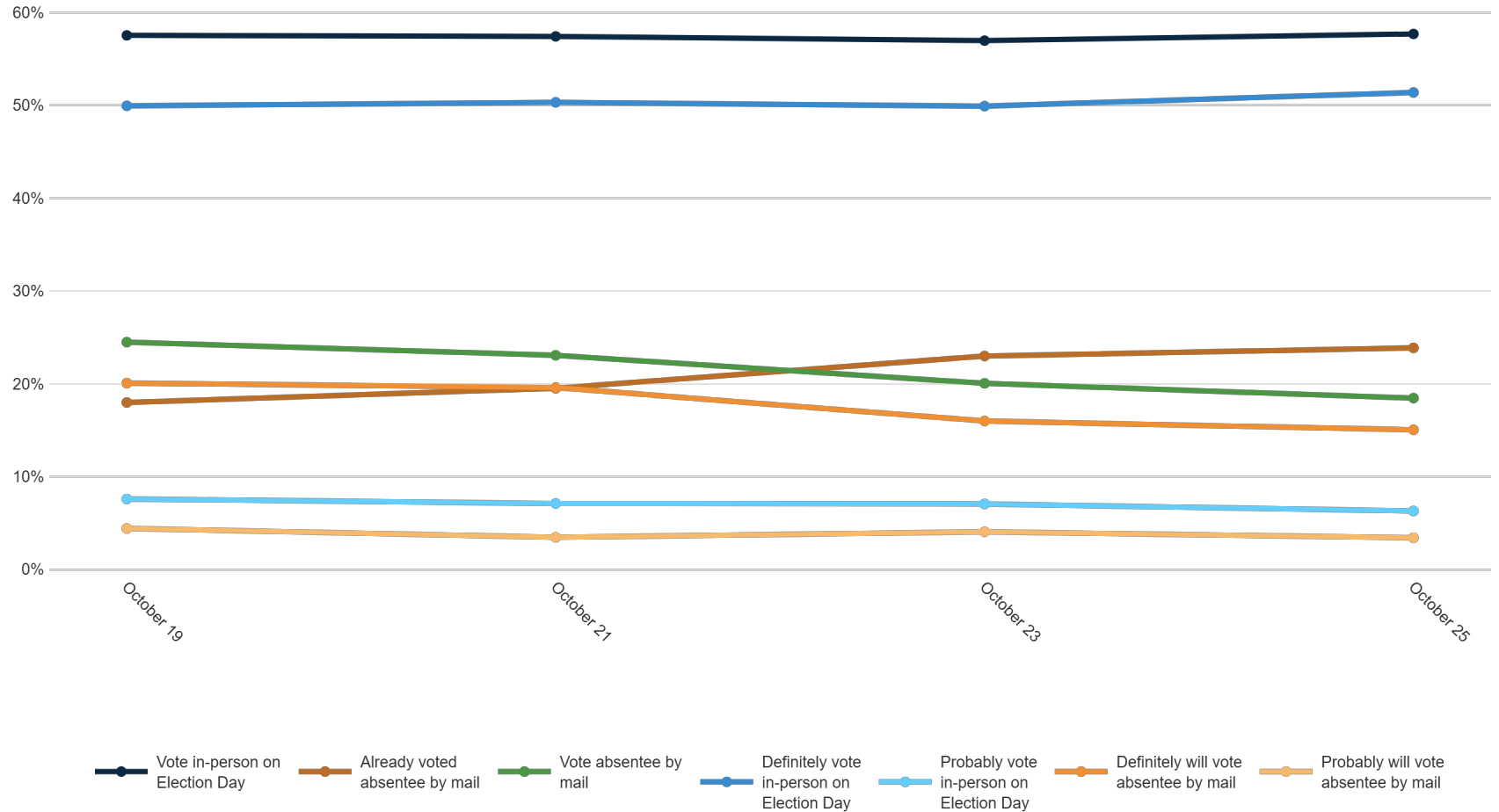

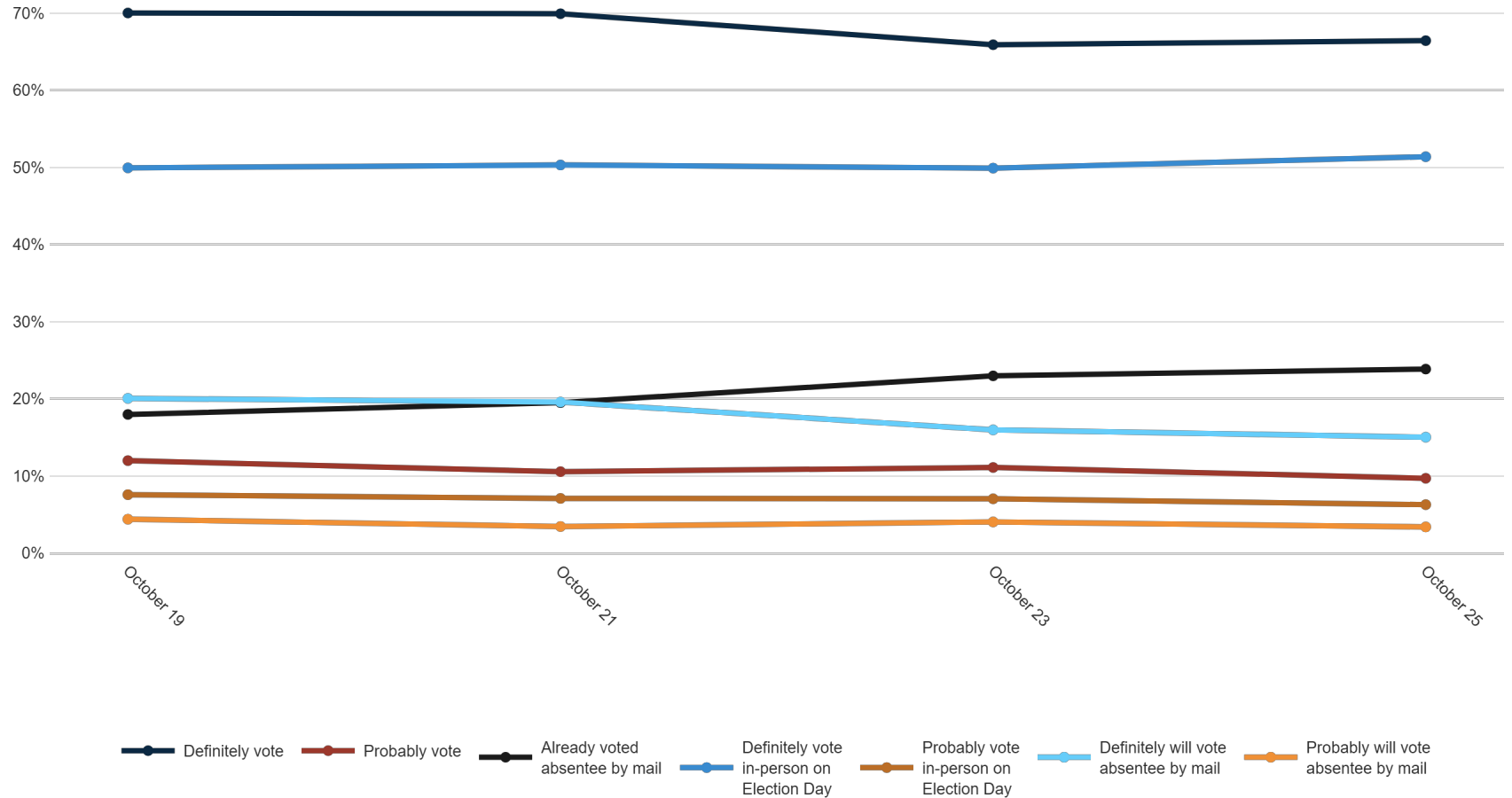
How do you plan to vote in the November election for Congress, Governor, and local offices?

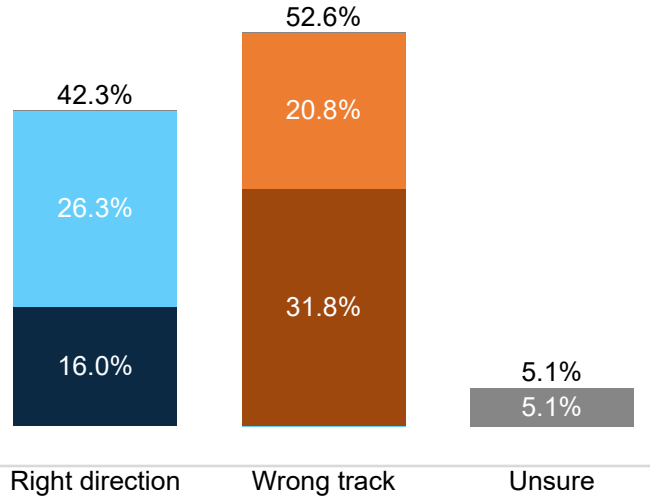
