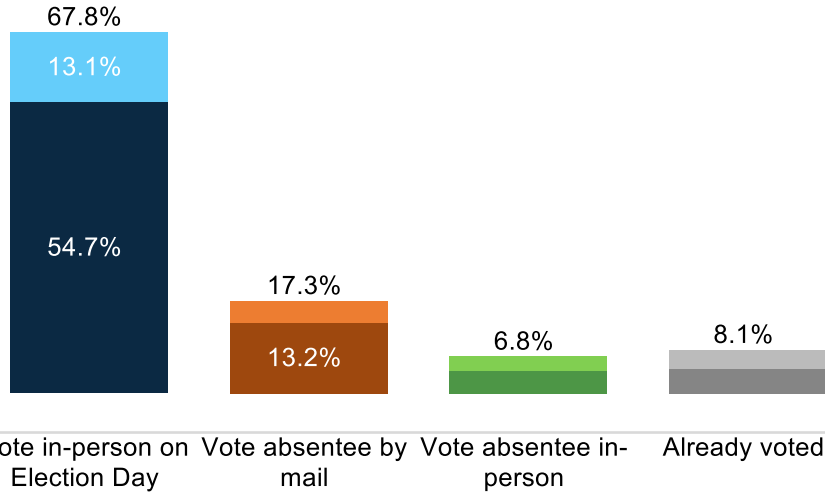

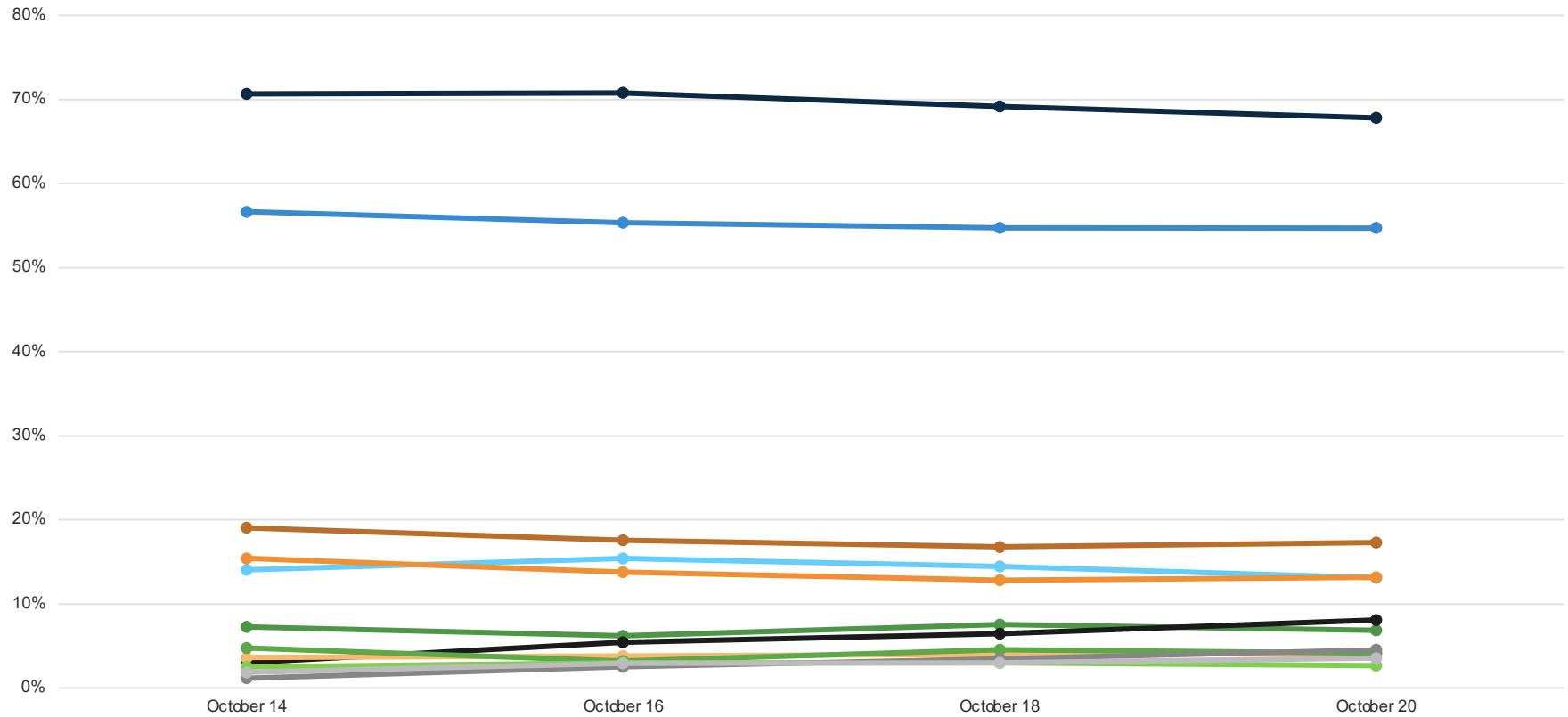

How do you plan to vote in the November general election for U.S. Senate, Governor, and state legislature?

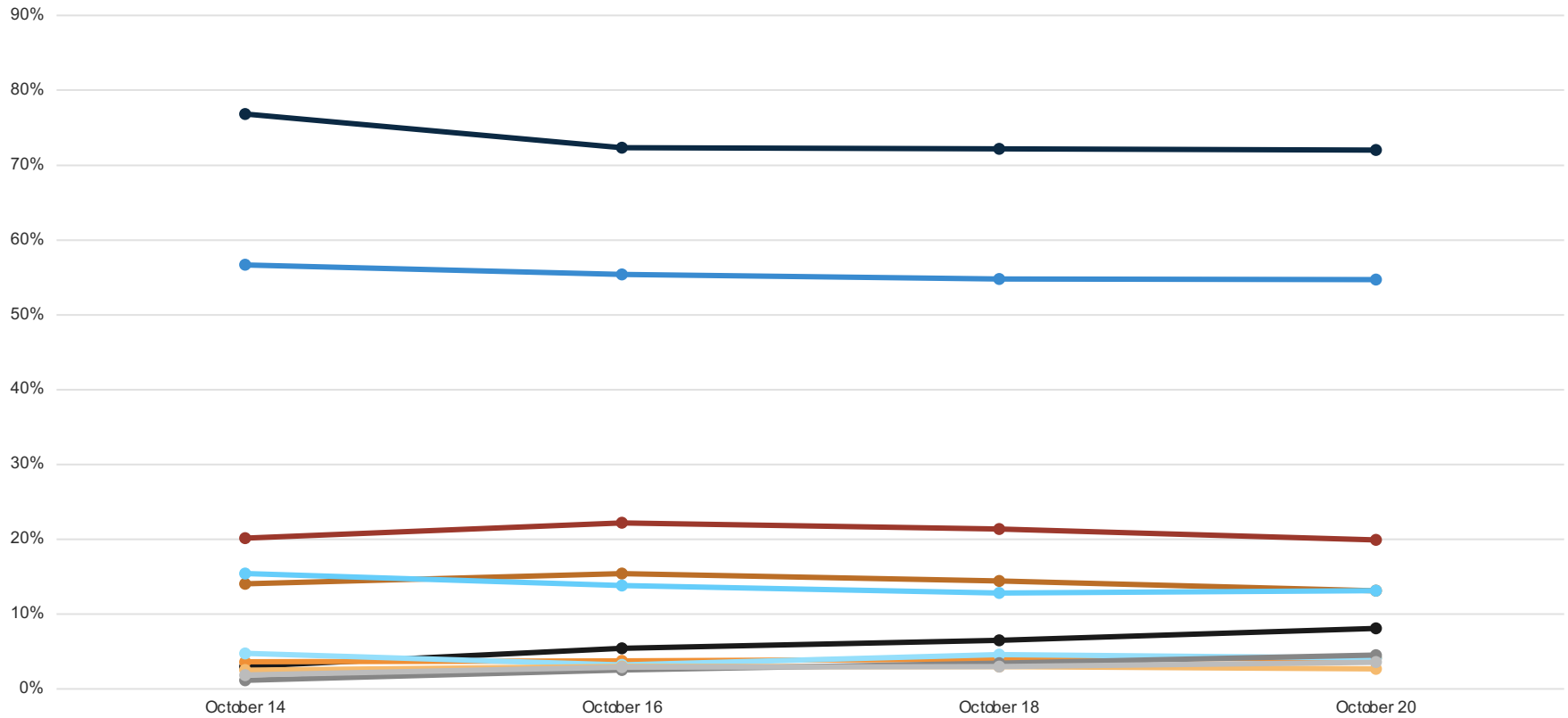

How excited are you to vote in the November general election for Governor, Congress, and state legislature on a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being not excited at all and 10 being very excited?

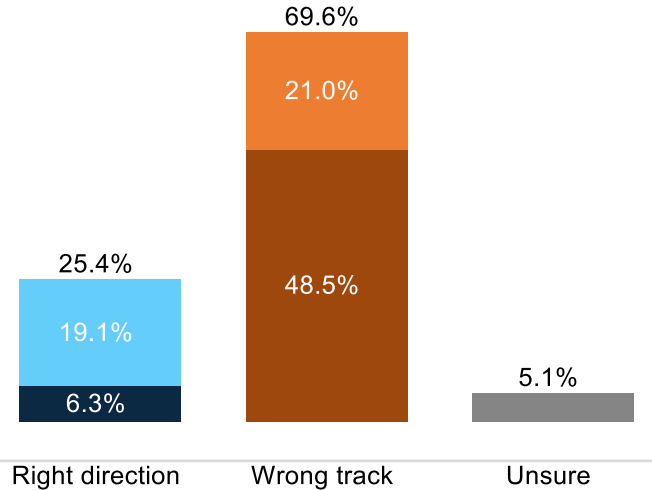
