




How do you plan to vote in the November election for Congress, Governor, and local offices?



Trend: Vote Method




Trend: Vote Method (Definitely/ Probably Vote)





How excited are you to vote in the November general election for Governor, Congress, and state legislature on a scale of 1 to 10, with 1 being not excited at all and 10 being very excited?








