

Evan Albertson

Senior Director, FP1 Strategies Texas

Evan Albertson has worked on tough races in over a dozen states. In 2016, he ran the top field office for U.S. Senator Rob Portman's reelection campaign. Albertson then served as the deputy national field director for the Congressional Leadership Fund during the 2018 midterms, where he helped launch and oversee a national field program that made 35 million voter contacts. When Texas Congressman Michael McCaul was listed as one of the top targets of the 2020 cycle, Albertson retooled the political operation and managed one of the most sophisticated congressional campaigns in the country. After that election, he remained a close advisor to Congressman McCaul while also taking a lead role in Texas Congressman Tony Gonzales' campaign. In a majority Hispanic district encompassing more of the U.S.-Mexico border than any other district, Albertson helped Congressman Gonzales achieve a 17-point victory while flipping multiple counties across South Texas that had not gone Republican in decades.



Paul Amarone

Advocacy Outreach Manager, Connecticut Business & Industry Association Connecticut

A seasoned operative who's managed campaigns at the local, state, and federal level, Paul Amarone has worked in Connecticut, New Hampshire, and Georgia. Amarone got his start with Mayor Erin Stewart of New Britain, CT, where he worked in her office and as statewide field director for her 2018 lieutenant governor run, and later as campaign manager for her re-election campaign in 2019, winning more than 60% of the vote in a city where Republicans are outnumbered by Democrats 6:1. Amarone went on to manage a special election campaign for state senate candidate Gennaro Bizzarro, helping flip the seat from blue to red for the first time in nearly 40 years. In 2020, Amarone worked as a Regional Field Director for the Trump Victory reelect in New Hampshire, working with Republicans up and down the ballot in NH-01 to assist in efforts that would profoundly re-elect Governor Chris Sununu and lead to Republicans growing majorities in the state legislature. After deploying to Georgia for the 2021 runoff, Amarone managed George Logan's race for Congress in CT-05. A race the incumbent won by double digits in 2020 and a seat Republicans haven't held in nearly two decades, Amarone assisted Logan in securing a unanimous convention nomination and becoming one of the highest profile target races in the country, with outside groups spending nearly \$15 million combined. Logan fell short by less than 1%, making it one of the top 10 closest races in the country. Amarone currently works as the Advocacy Outreach Manager for Public Policy at CBIA, Connecticut's largest and most impactful business association, representing more than 3,000 businesses at the state capitol. Amarone is a graduate of Assumption College, where he studied political science and was a four-year member of the NCAA-D2 ice hockey team and founder of the Assumption College Young Conservatives Club.



Alex Blair

Chief of Staff, Congressman Greg Steube (FL-17) Florida

Alex has worked in government and Republican politics for roughly ten years. His career began in the private sector where he worked for a start-up digital consulting firm and developed skills that would help him manage multiple political campaigns at the state and federal levels. These successful campaigns led to opportunities working in the Florida legislature and Congress, where in 2019 he became the youngest serving Chief of Staff in the US House of Representatives under Congressman Greg Steube, a position he continues to hold today.
