Survey of Likely General Election Voters **National**

Insights & Analysis

- America has started voting. As of October 3rd, **3% of Americans have already cast their ballot**. These voters - though a small sample size - are **heavily Democratic**, older, more female, and less likely to be religious. They are performing in their 2024 vote choice the same as they did in 2020 – 3:1 Democrat (Biden now Harris) over Republican (Trump).
- Now slightly less than 2:1 “wrong direction”, voters’ views on the **direction of our country have become slightly less negative**, moving from 71% wrong track / 24% right direction at the beginning of July to 61% wrong track / 33% right direction this month. That’s a net 19-point movement.
- The overall **political environment remains tight**. A generic Republican increased +1 to an R+2 advantage. However, this continued slight lead is built on a growing number of voters saying “Probably Republican” (from 8% in Aug to 10% in early Oct). Comparatively a generic Democrat has added 1 point to “Definitely Democrat” in that same time.
 - Voters **undecided** on the generic congressional ballot are **heavily female**. They are much younger than voters as a whole and more likely to be moderate and Independent. These undecided voters are **least likely to be reached on cable**, instead heavily consuming their news **online and on social**.
- Despite the continued glowing mainstream media coverage and advertising advantage for **Harris**, she **remains only slightly ahead of Trump** on both the full (Trump 45 – Harris 47) and head-to-head ballots (Trump 47 – Harris 50) – though she has grown her ballot share every month since entering the race compared to Trump’s steady ballot share.
 - Harris’ slightly increased margins are driven mostly by younger women and some Republicans moving her way since last month.
 - Independents and college-educated men shifted in Trump’s direction.

Insights & Analysis

- The margin of who voters **believe will win the election** (Harris 45 – Trump 42) is **reflective of the margin on the presidential ballot**.
 - Belief in Trump is weaker among Republicans (Trump 80 – Harris 11) than belief in Harris among Democrats (Trump 5 – Harris 83). Independents believe Harris will win +8 despite being only Harris +3 on the ballot.
 - In contrast to the relative confidence in a Harris victory, **a plurality of voters believe their neighbors are voting for Trump** (44%) compared to 32% for Harris. A quarter are unsure who their neighbors are voting for. Rural voters (Trump 59 – Harris 13) are most sure of their neighbors supporting Trump, Suburban voters (Trump 43 – Harris 32) slightly less so, and urban voters (Trump 19 – Harris 59) are more confident in their neighbors voting for Harris.
- **Women under the age of 55** are voting for Harris by +22 and believe by +20 Harris will win the election, but they have a very different view of who their **neighbors are supporting, saying Trump+2**.
 - 69% of Trump 2020 voters believe their neighbors are voting for Trump, while only 54% of Biden 2020 voters believe their neighbors are voting for Harris (and 21% believe their neighbors are voting for Trump).
- **Harris** continues to be viewed **more positively than Trump**, and both candidates had their images marginally improve from last month (Harris +1 fav, -1 unfav // Trump +1 fav, -1 unfav).
 - Notably, under the hood, Harris' image among **Independents net shifted -10 points**, going from a **+6 net favorability to -4**. Trump's image among the same group shifted +13 points, but he remains 21 points underwater with them.
- After the VP debate, **Walz's image remains generally consistent** (+2 fav, +3 unfav), while **Vance's image had serious positive movement** from 40% very unfavorable and 22% very favorable (-18 net very unfav) to 36% very unfavorable and 32% very favorable (only -4 net very unfav).

Insights & Analysis

- Vance's image improved across the board, notably with **urban voters** (+19 net fav shift) and **Independents** (+26 net fav shift). Among the same groups, **Walz's image dipped** -8 net fav and -12 net fav, respectively.
- A third of Americans believe there should be full Republican control of Washington, and another third believe there should be full control Democratic of Washington.
 - 12% want to see a Republican president and split control of Congress.
 - 14% want to see a Democrat president and split control of Congress.
 - Republicans are slightly more inclined to favor a mix of power than Democrats, including **5% of Republicans who want a Democratic president and split control of Congress** compared to only 1% of Democrats who want to see a Republican president and split control of Congress.
- Voters are divided on **whether Trump** (48%) **or Harris'** (49%) **policies are better for them**. Independents and men shifted more toward wanting Trump's policies since September.
- Only a third of Republicans believe Harris is "fully responsible" for the policies of the Biden-Harris Administration, while 51% believe she is either "mostly" or "somewhat responsible".
 - Independents believe she is only 25% "somewhat" and 24% "slightly responsible".
- A majority of voters (58%) typically decide their preferred candidate for Congress in a presidential election year **more than a month before Election Day**. Independents are slightly more inclined to decide a few weeks before (18%).
 - Nearly a fifth of voters under 55 and urban voters **wait until Election Day**, and that number increases to over a quarter of Black, Hispanic, and lower-propensity voters.

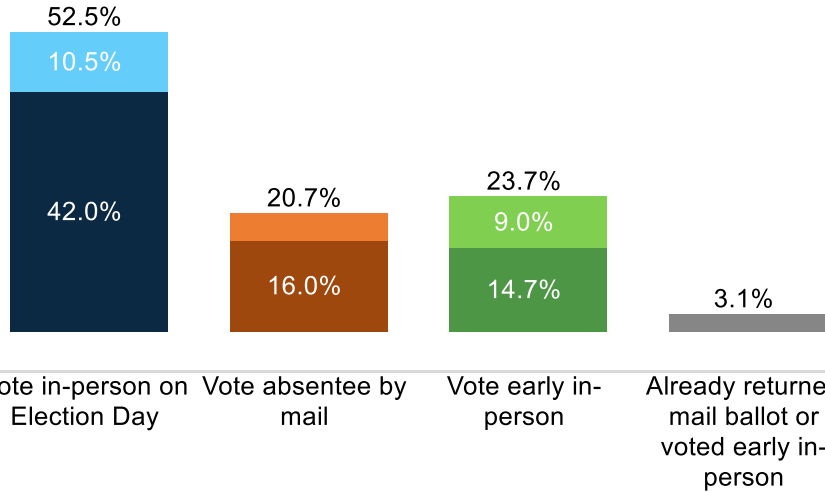
Insights & Analysis

- How **voters are consuming news** is changing as the election draws closer.
 - Black voters are paying much more attention to X while news consumption on Facebook among Hispanics doubled. YouTube also grew significantly among non-white voters.
 - **Cable news** as a source is **down** across-the-board.
 - National broadcast is also down except for newly registered voters.
 - **Trump is doing better across all news source mediums compared to how voters in each medium voted in 2020.**
- In a surprising turn of events, nearly half of Americans believe pineapple belongs on pizza. Democrats lean more strongly “yes” while older men are the most repulsed by this yellow fruit on their pizza pie.
 - **Lower-propensity voters** are much more likely to believe **pineapple on pizza** is ok compared to those who have voted more often.
- **Independent voters are more likely to listen to rock music** (59%) compared to Republicans (46%) or Democrats (46%).
 - **Lower-propensity voters** are more likely to listen to **rap/hip-hop and pop** compared to those who vote more regularly.
 - Older female voters drive country music.
 - Black voters and Republicans drive the listenership of Christian music.
 - **College-educated voters** are two-times more likely to listen to **classical music** than those without a college degree.
 - **Half of Trump 2020 voters listen to country music** compared to only a quarter of Biden 2020 voters.

Insights & Analysis

- The consensus is that the **Christmas seasons official begins** in late November (36%) or early December (27%) – it's something **voters of all political stripes can agree** upon.
- Segmentation analysis via machine learning identified five electoral groups: **GOP Base** (35%), **Lean GOP** (10%), **Persuadables** (7%), **Lean Dem** (17%), and **Dem Base** (31%).
 - The **Lean GOP** segment is more moderate, younger, less educated, lower income, and less religious than the *GOP Base* segment. These voters are also more likely think the Republican Party is more extreme than the *GOP Base* segment, and they are focused on inflation above all else.
 - The **Persuadable** segment is **most focused on inflation and the economy over any other segment**. They lean for the generic Republican and Trump, and three quarters believe Trump's policies are better for them. They are the most female-leaning, moderate, rural, and Midwest-centered segment.
 - The **Lean Dem** segment skews female, younger, liberal, lower income, likely to be single, and less educated than the *Dem Base* segment. A distinct difference between the *Lean Dem* segment and the *Dem Base* segment is that the *Lean Dem* segment is focused on inflation and the economy, whereas the *Dem Base* segment's top issue is threats to democracy.

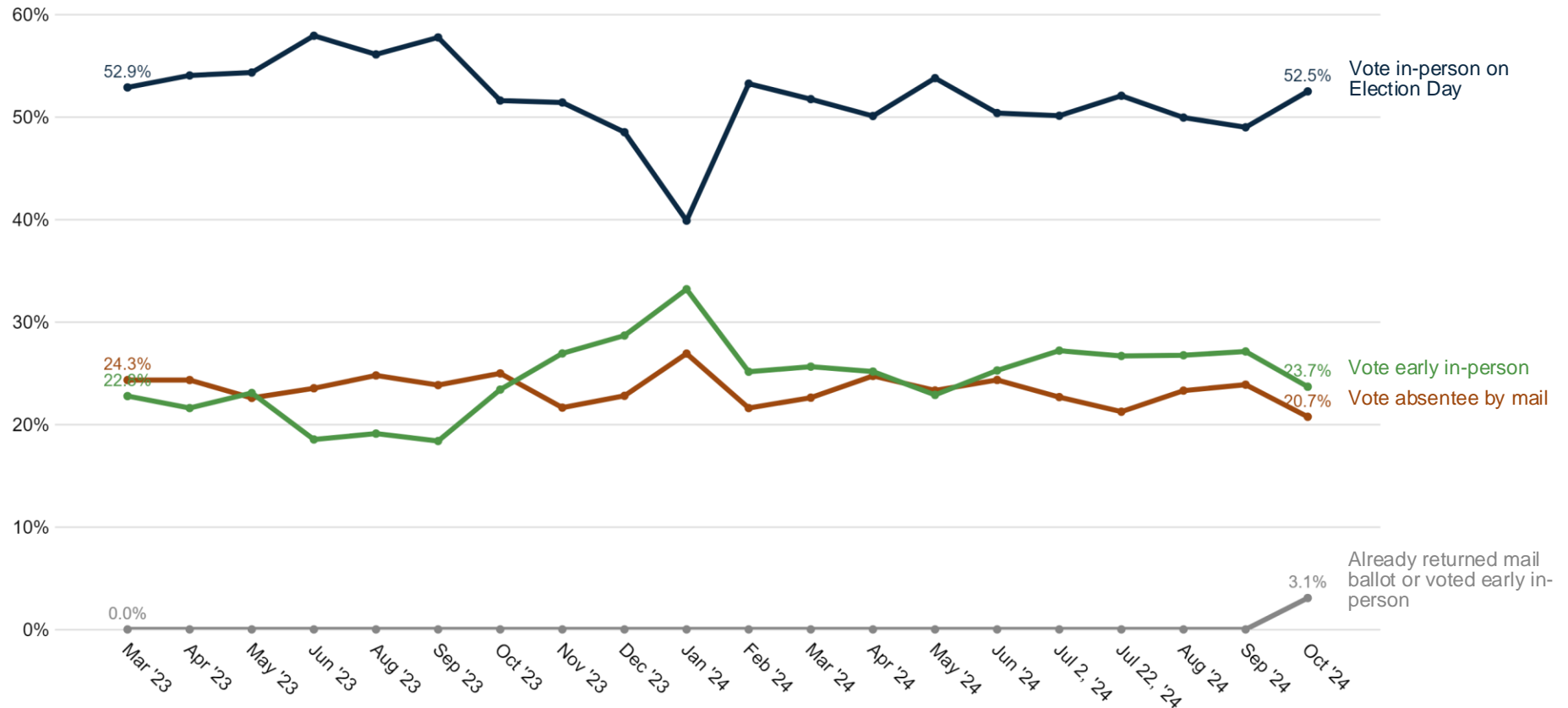

How do you plan to vote in the November 5th general election for President, U.S. Congress, and state offices?

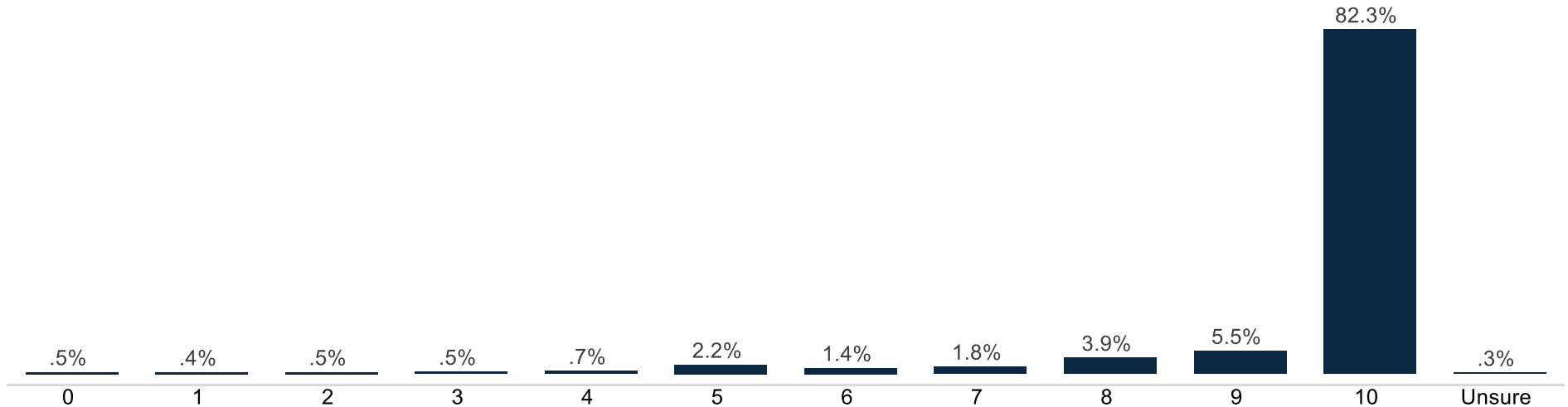

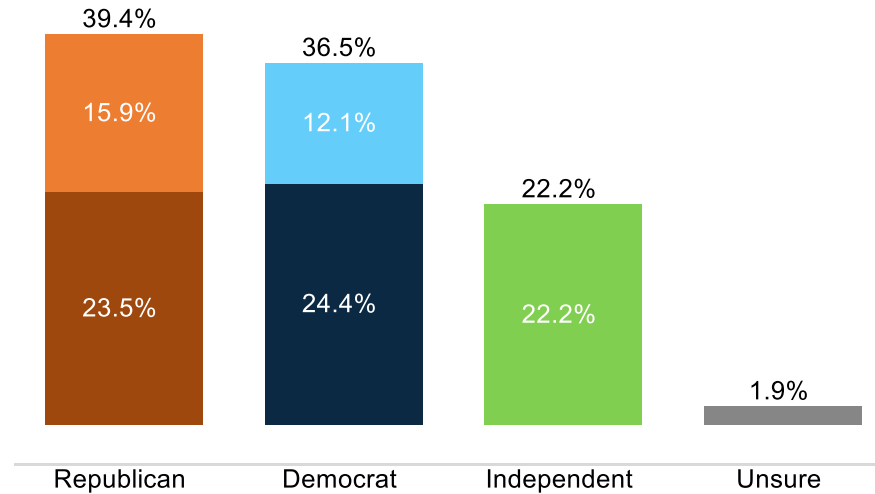

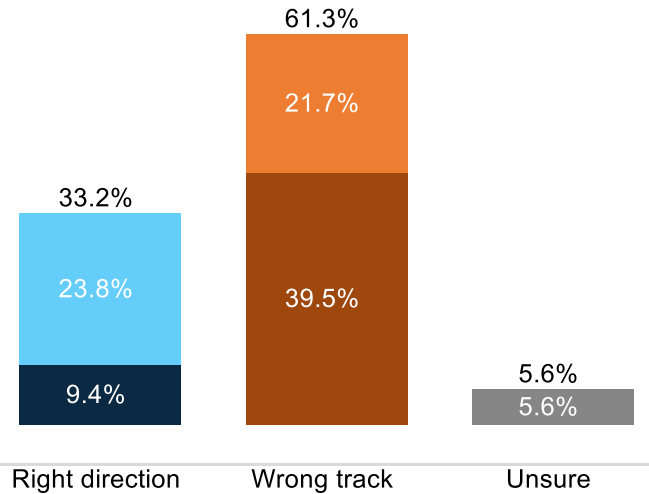
Partisanship by Response

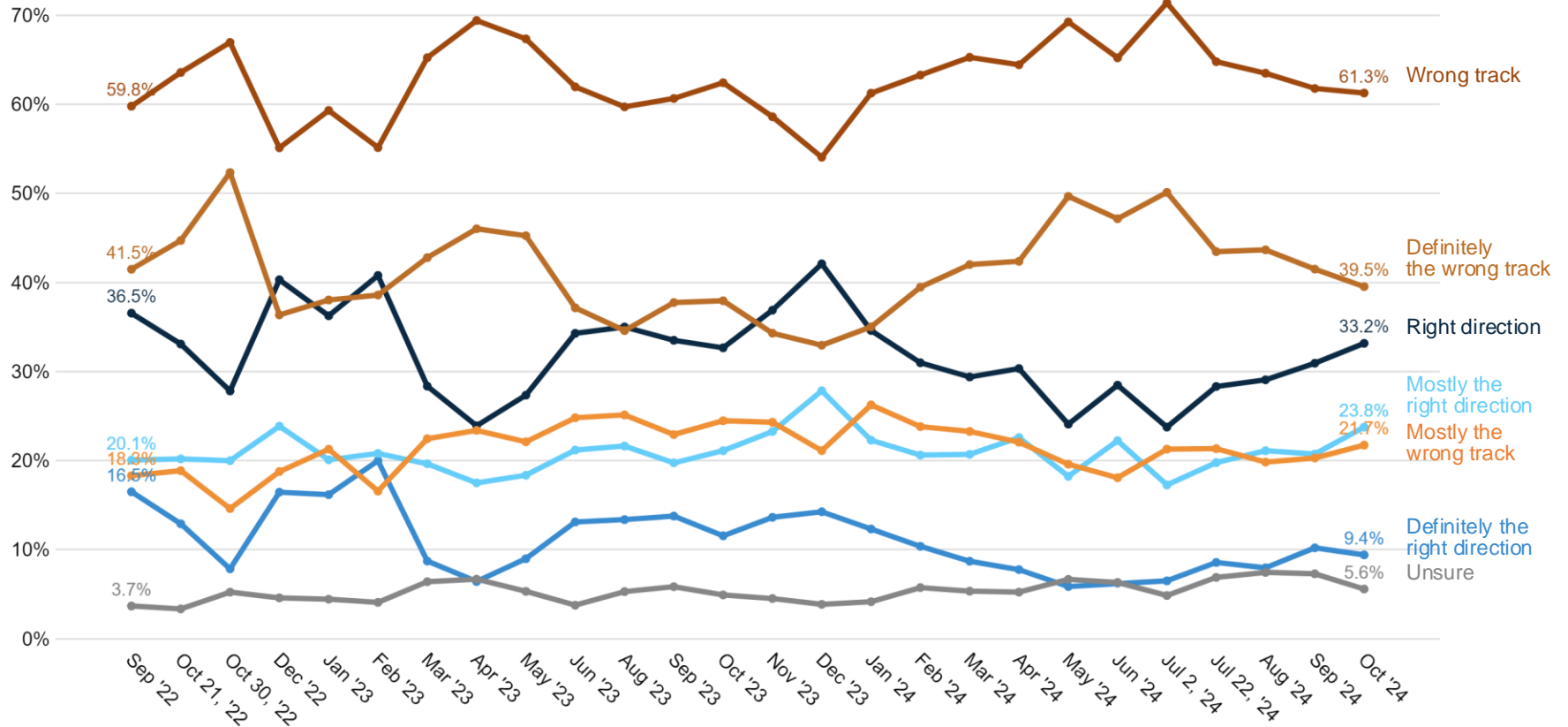

Generally speaking, would you say things in the United States are headed in the right direction or off on the wrong track?

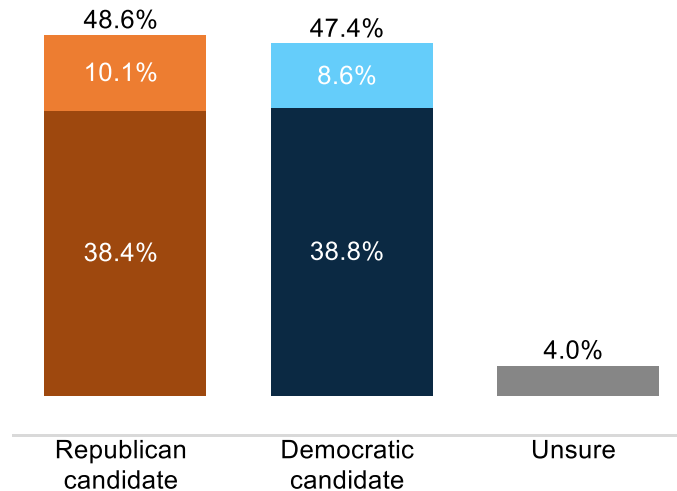
Trend: US Direction

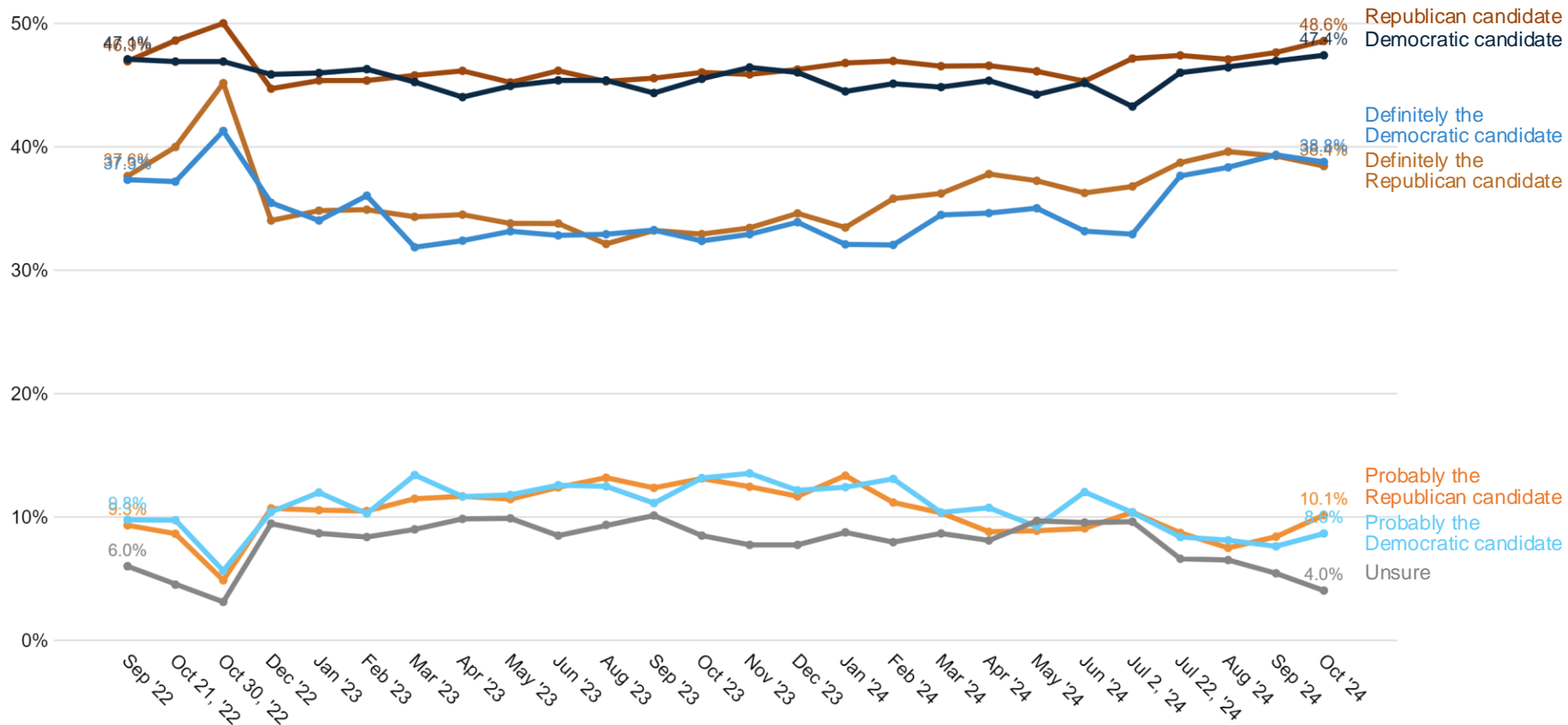
Generic Ballot

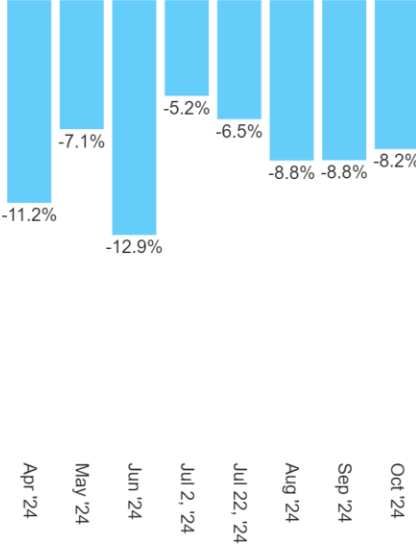

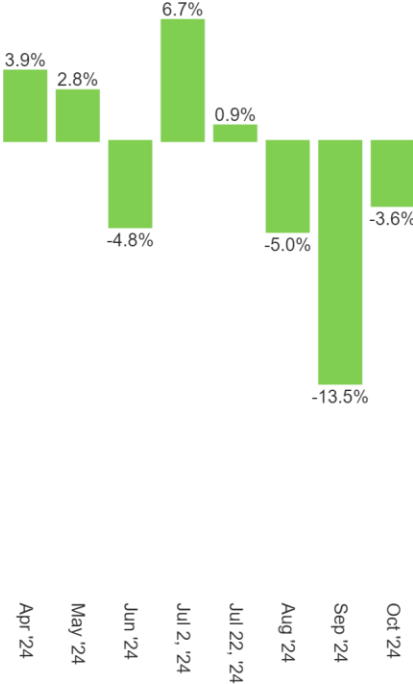

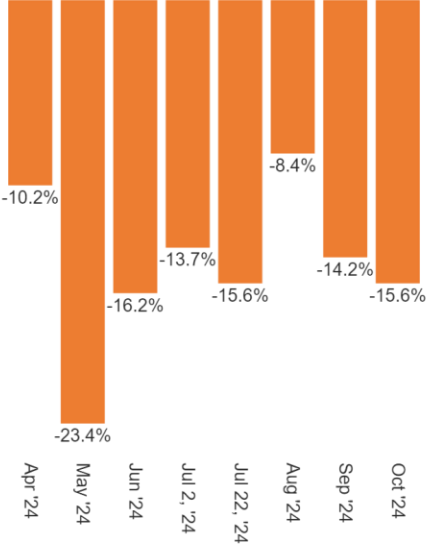

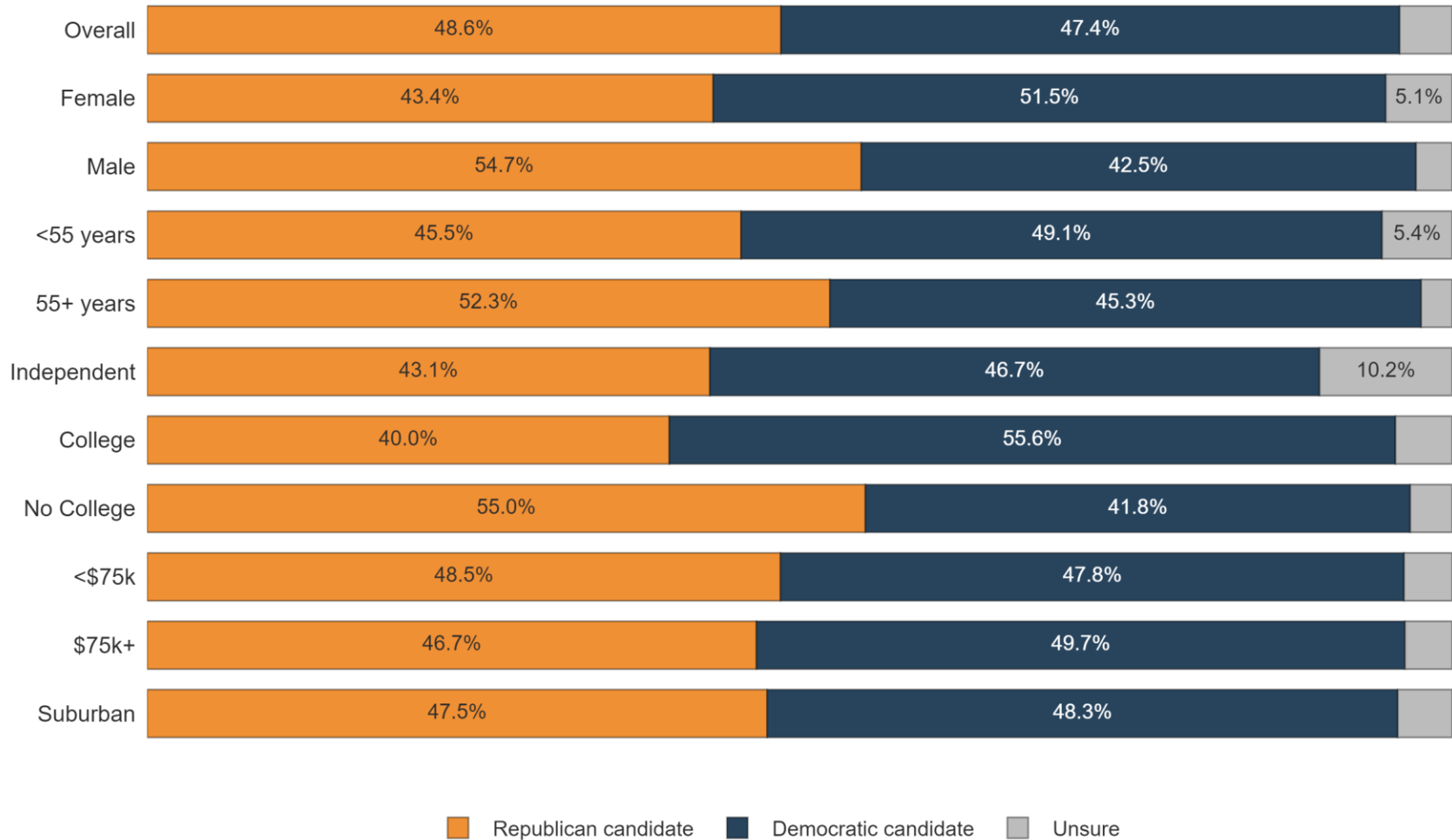

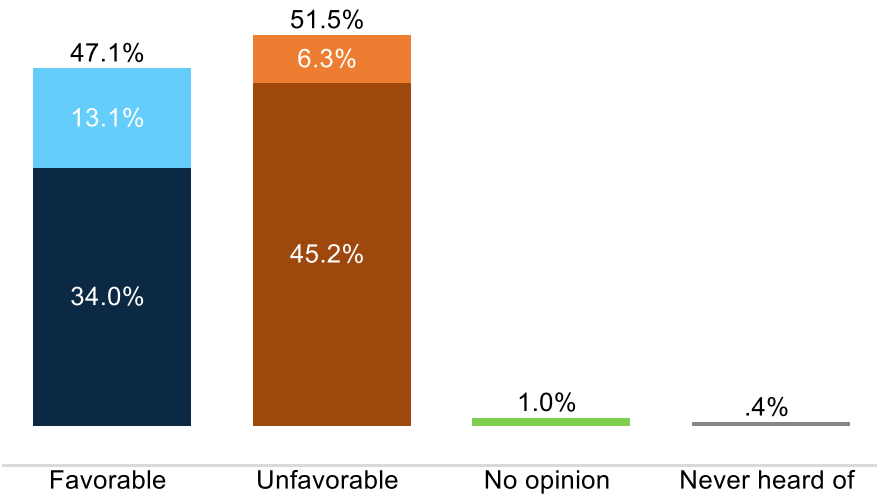

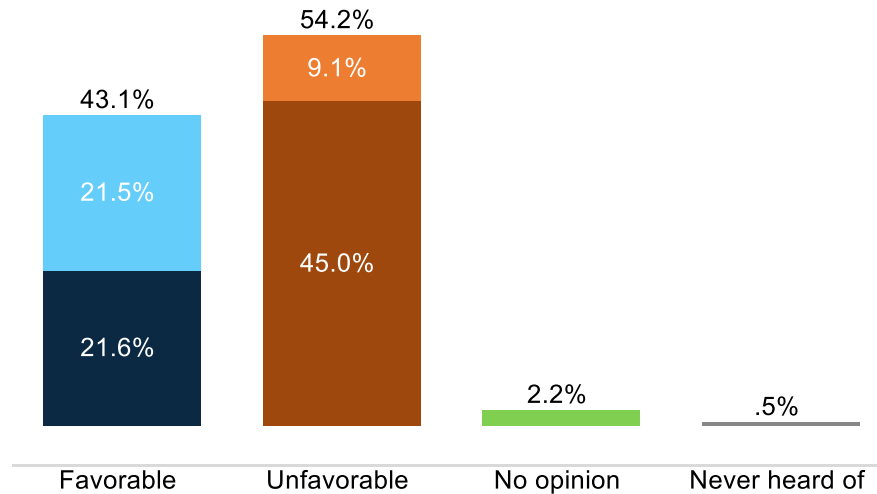

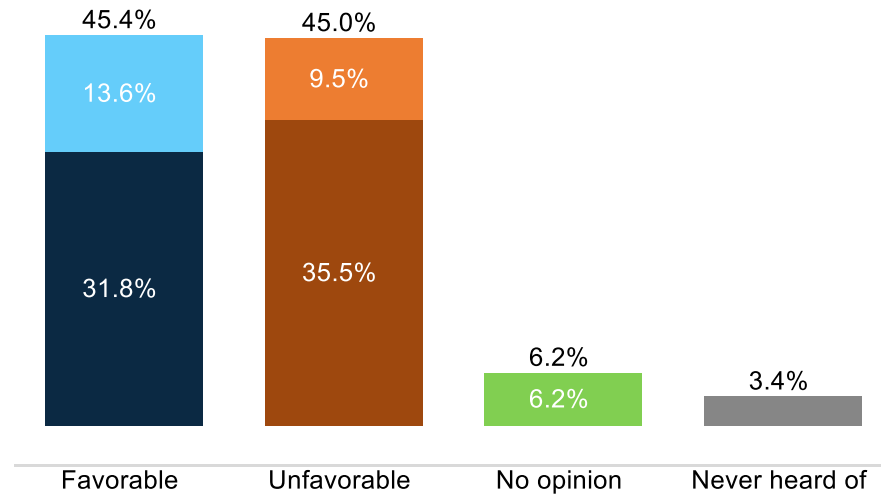

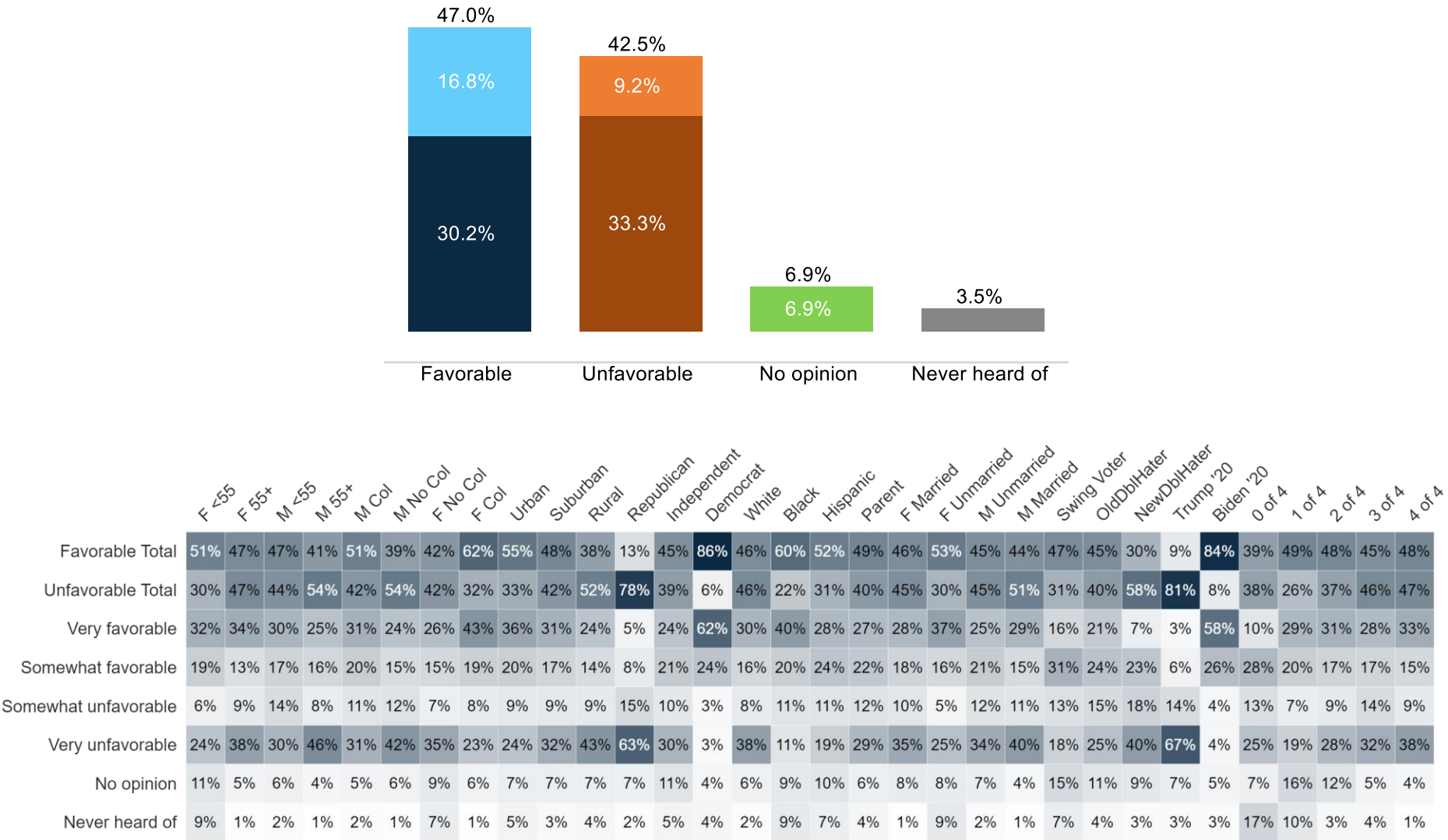

Do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Tim Walz?

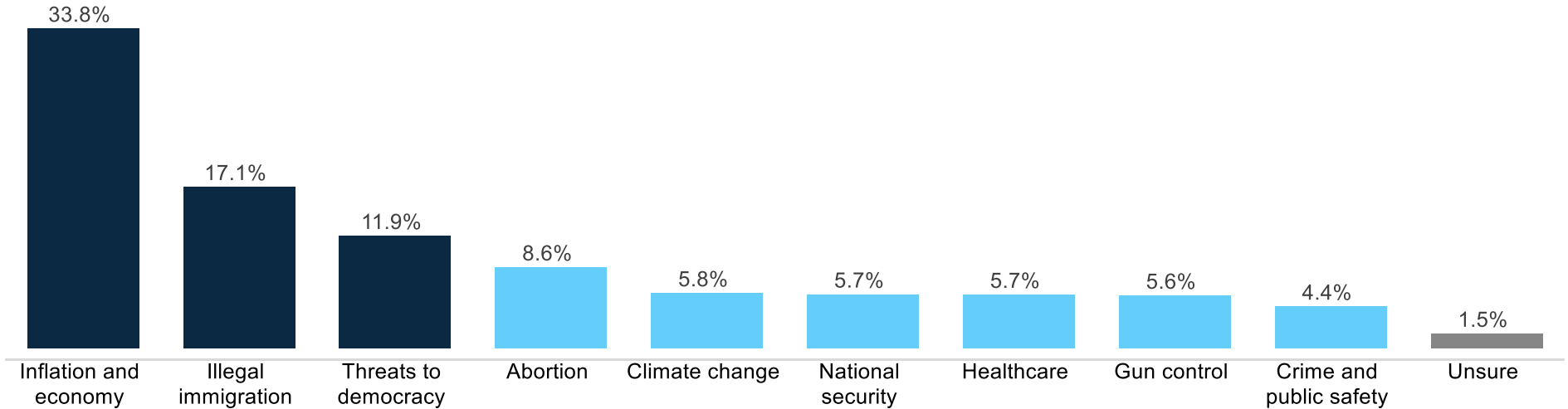

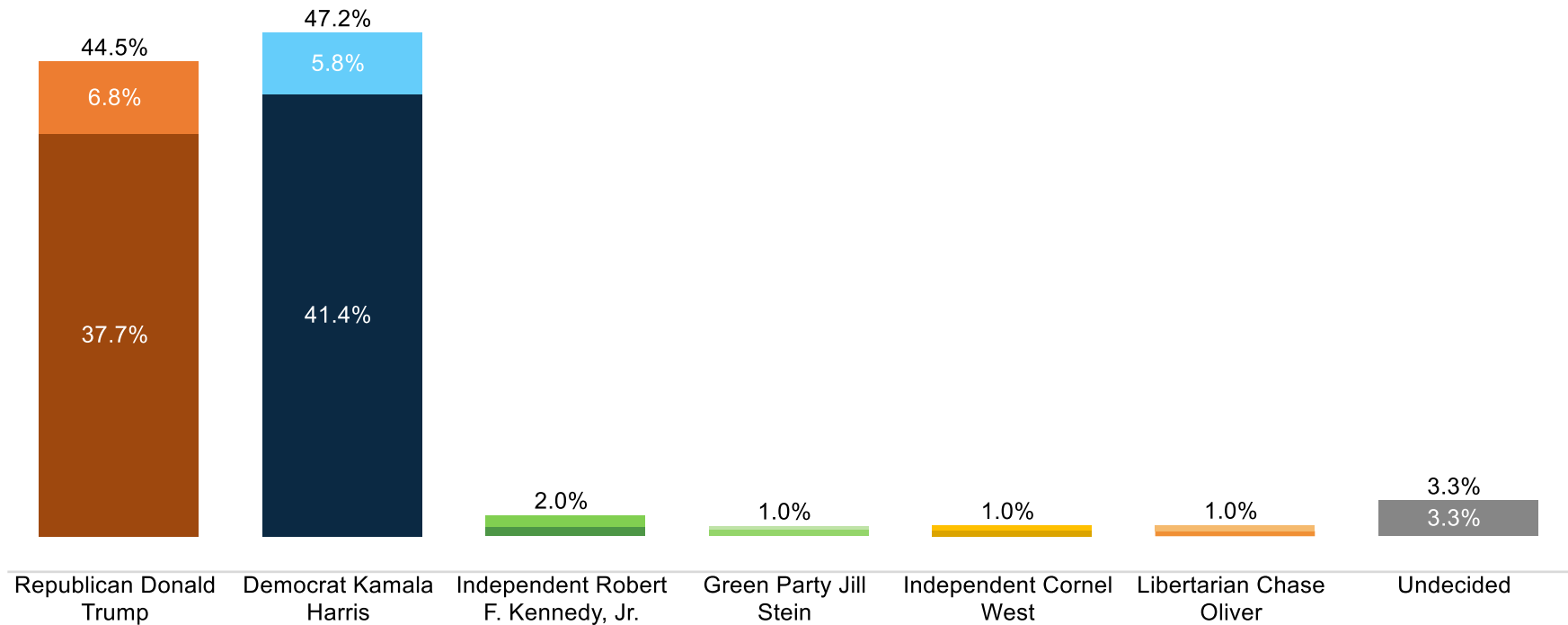

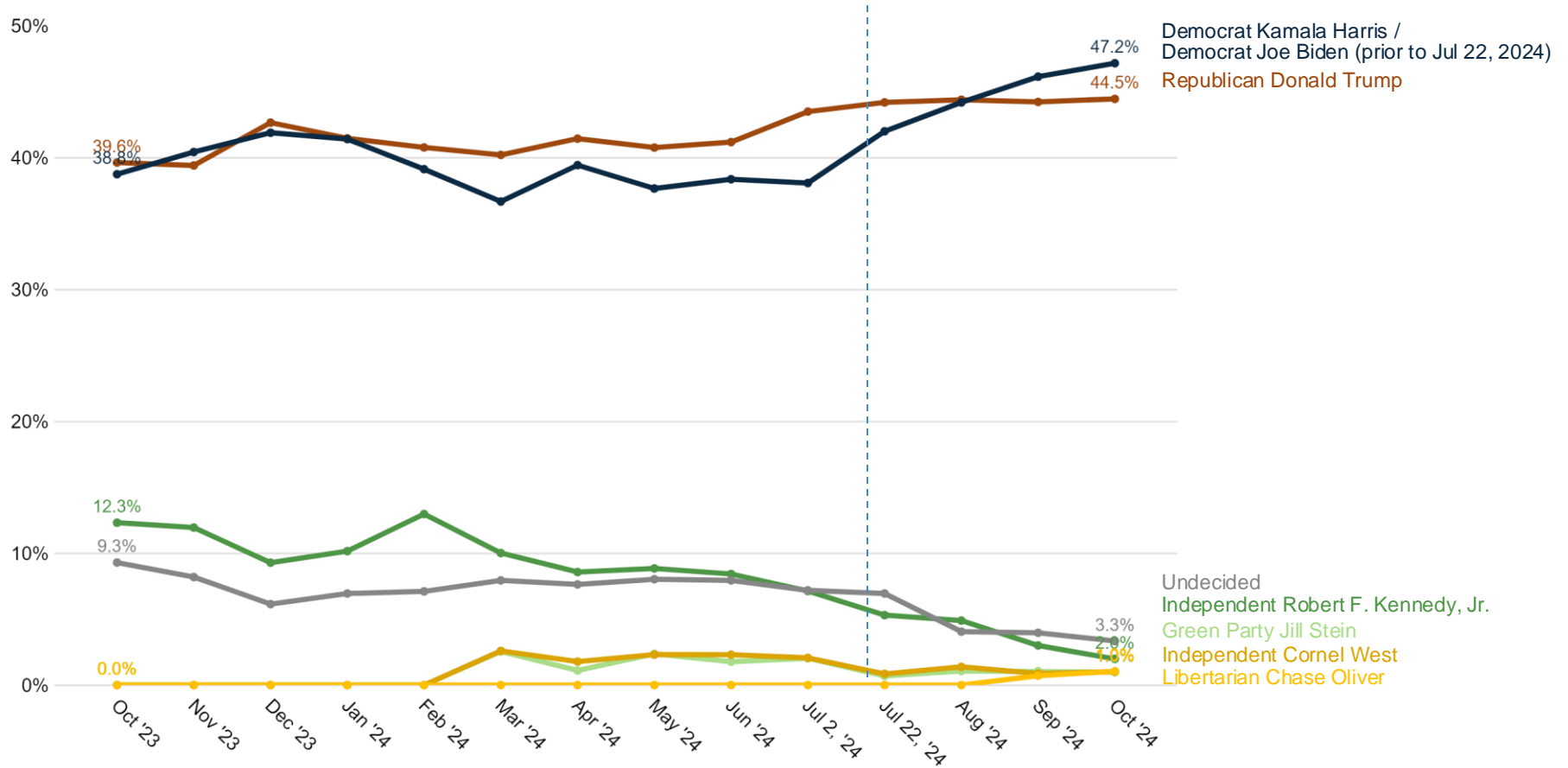

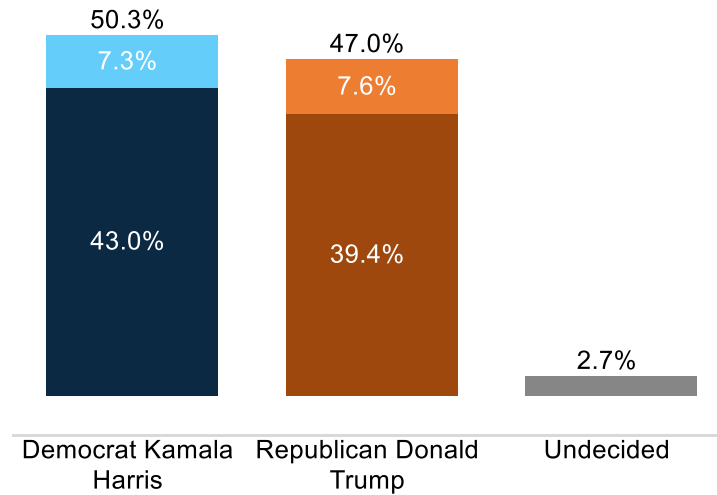

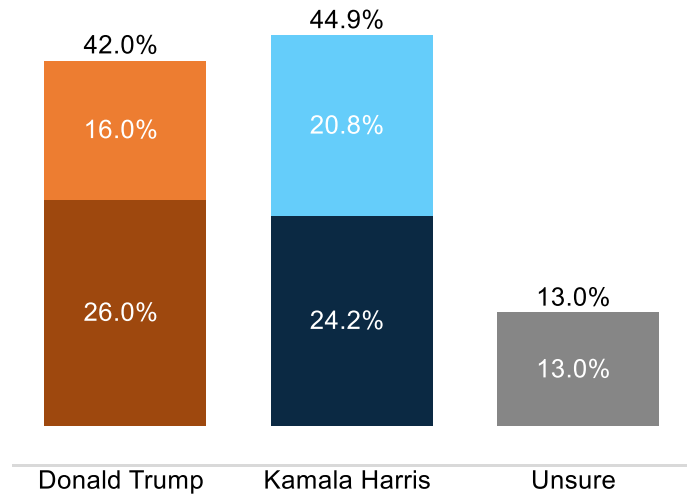

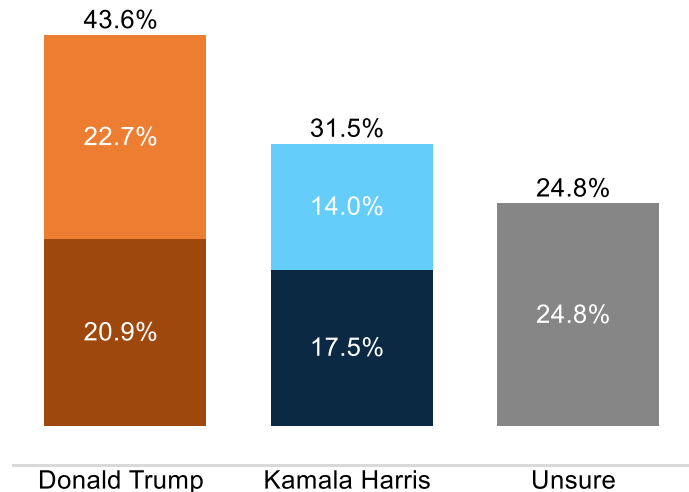

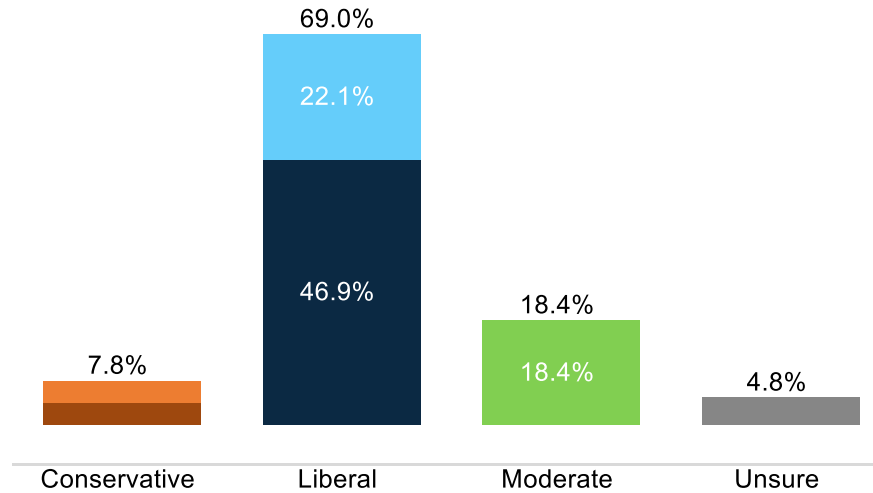

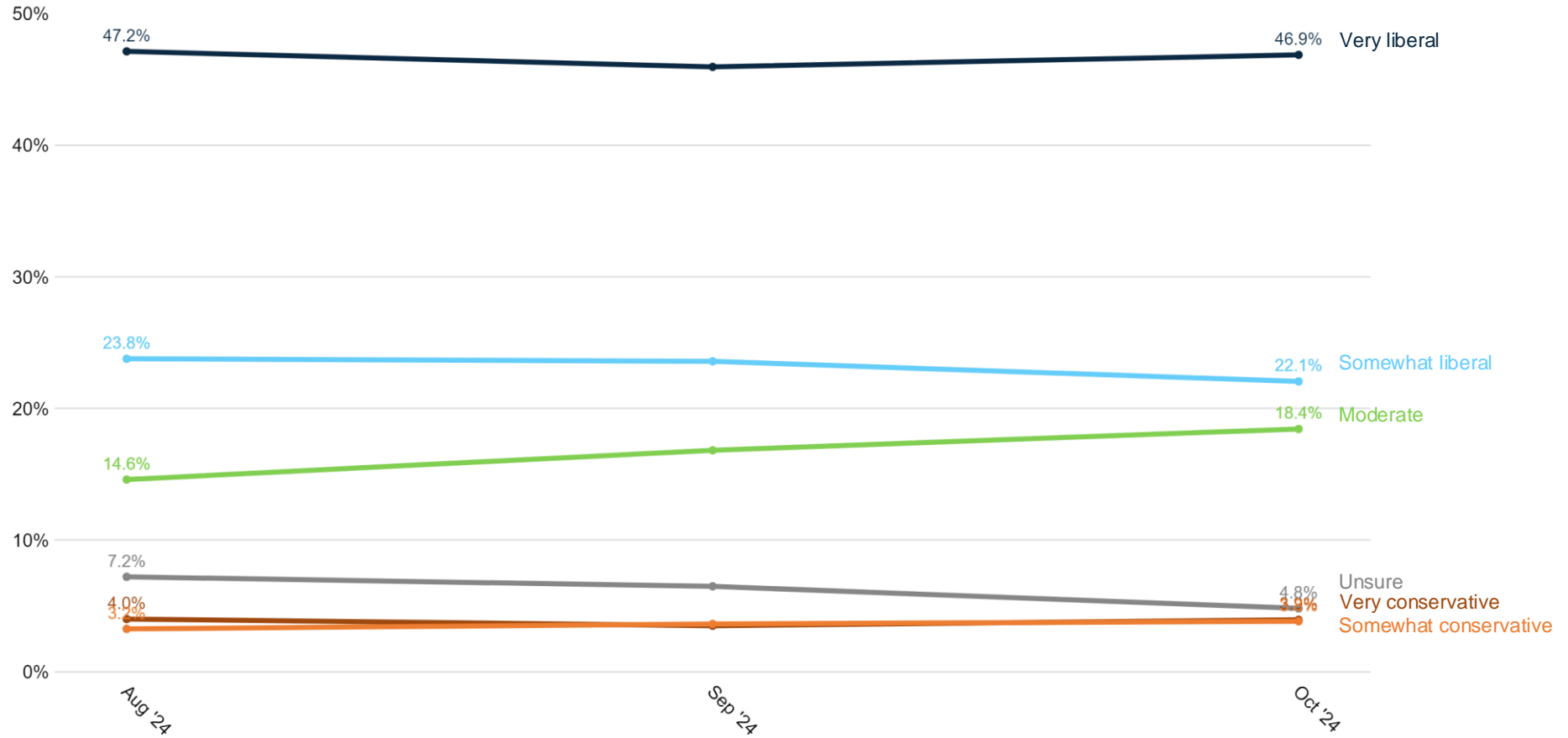

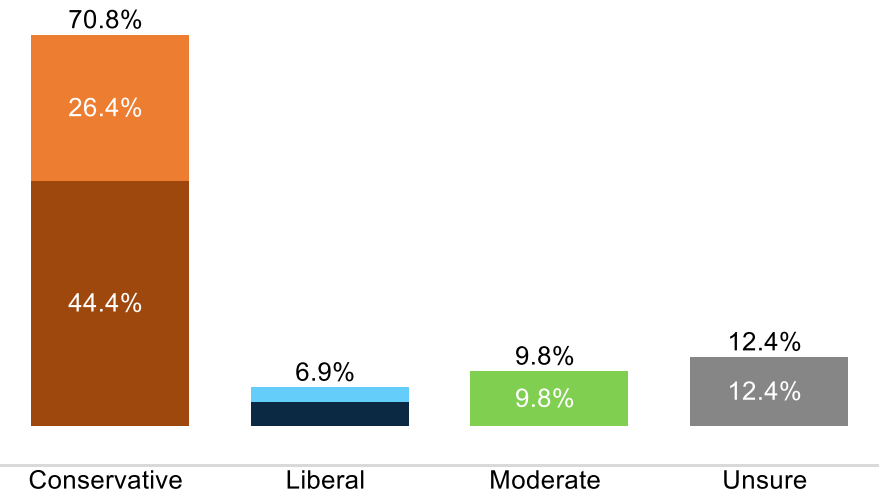

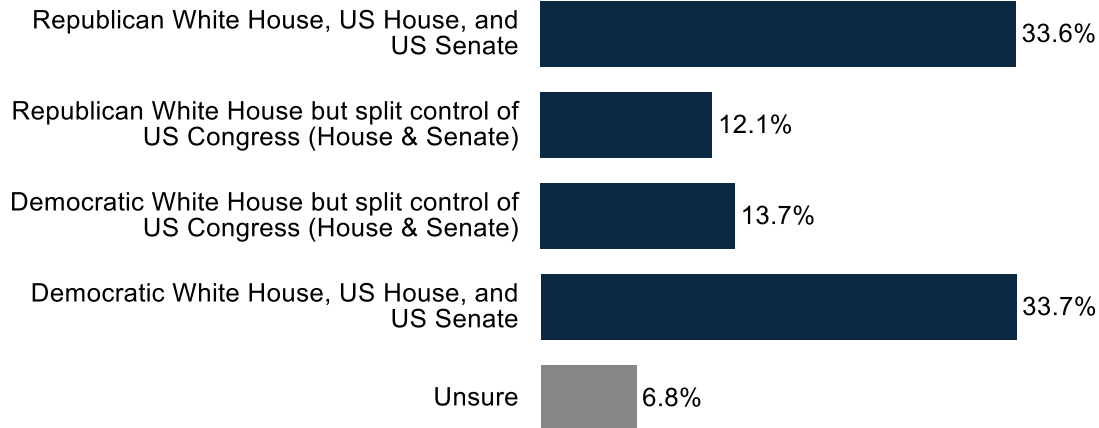

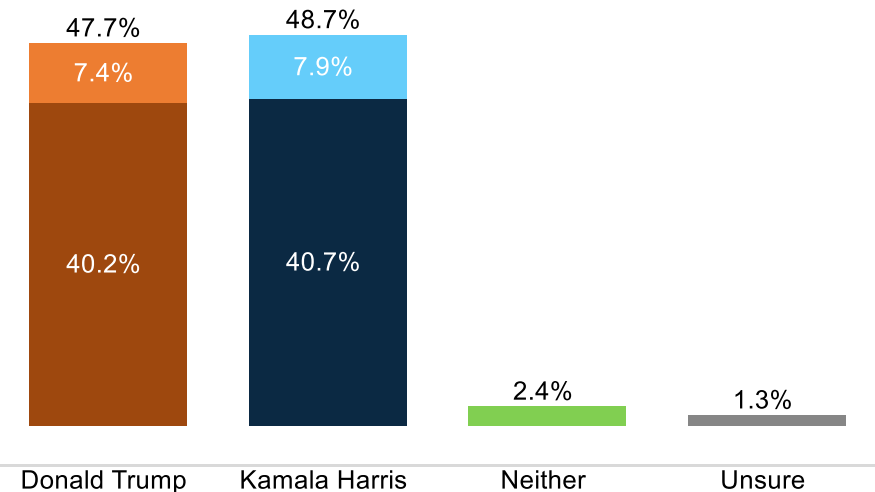

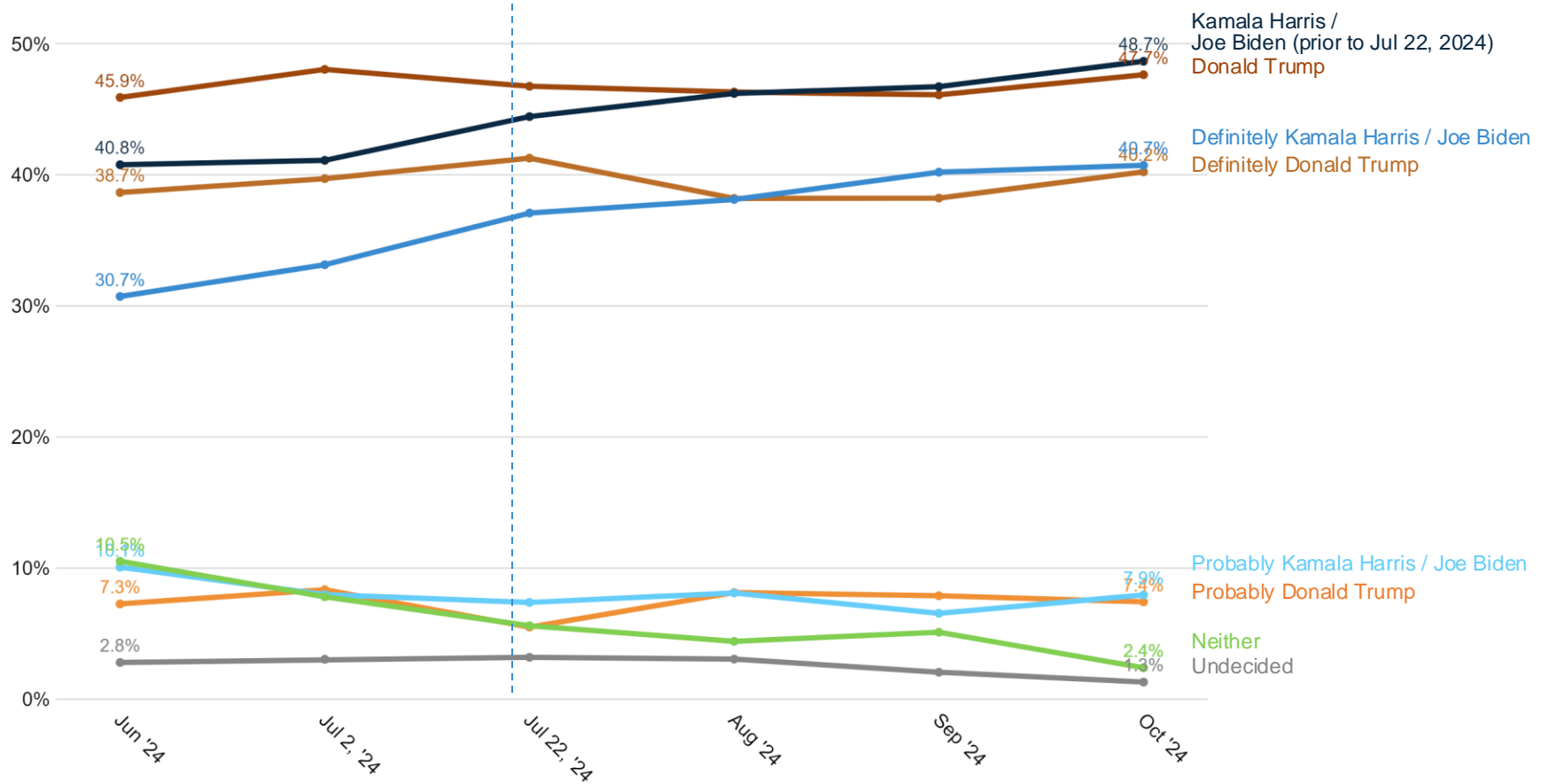

Trend: Trump v Harris Policy Contrast*

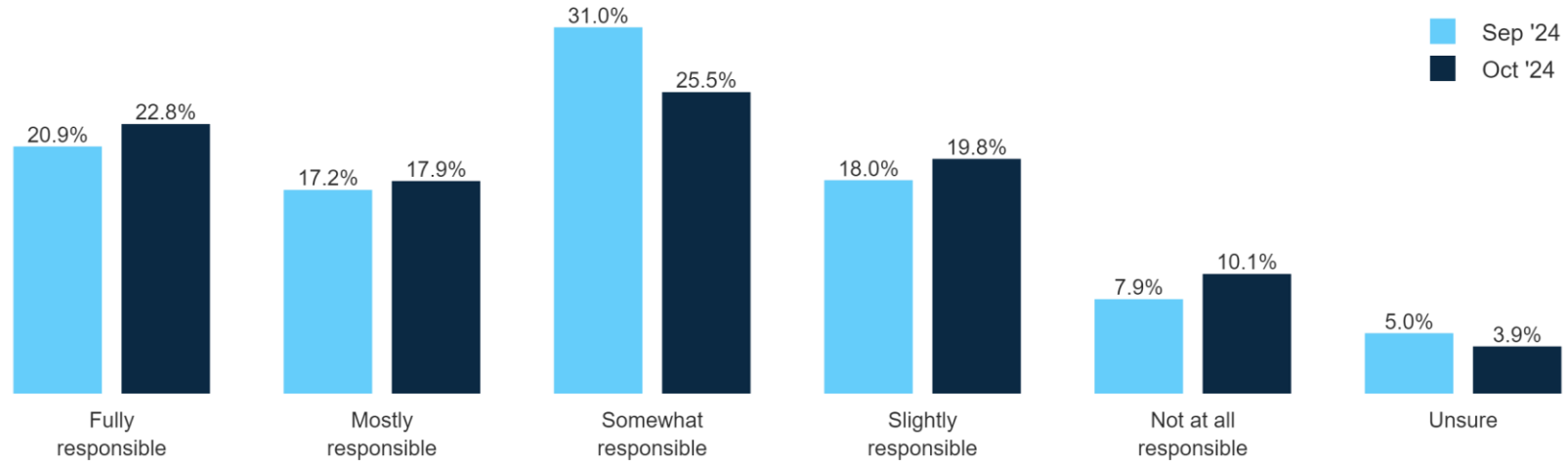

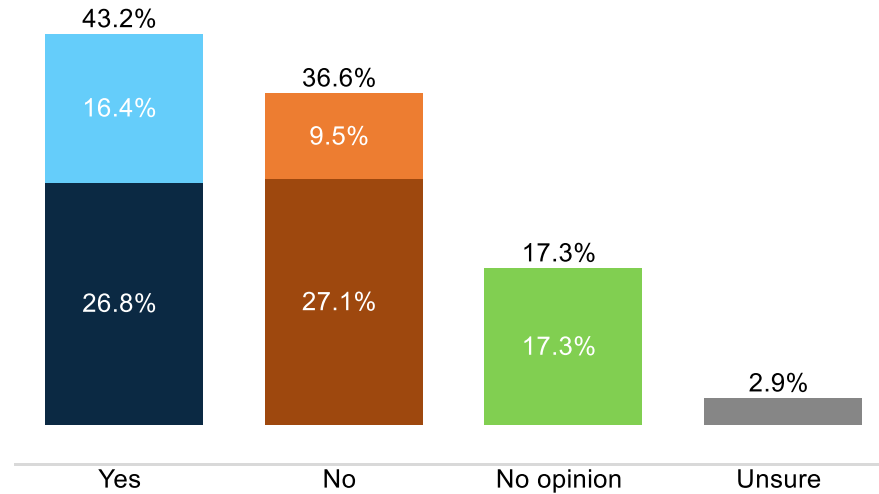

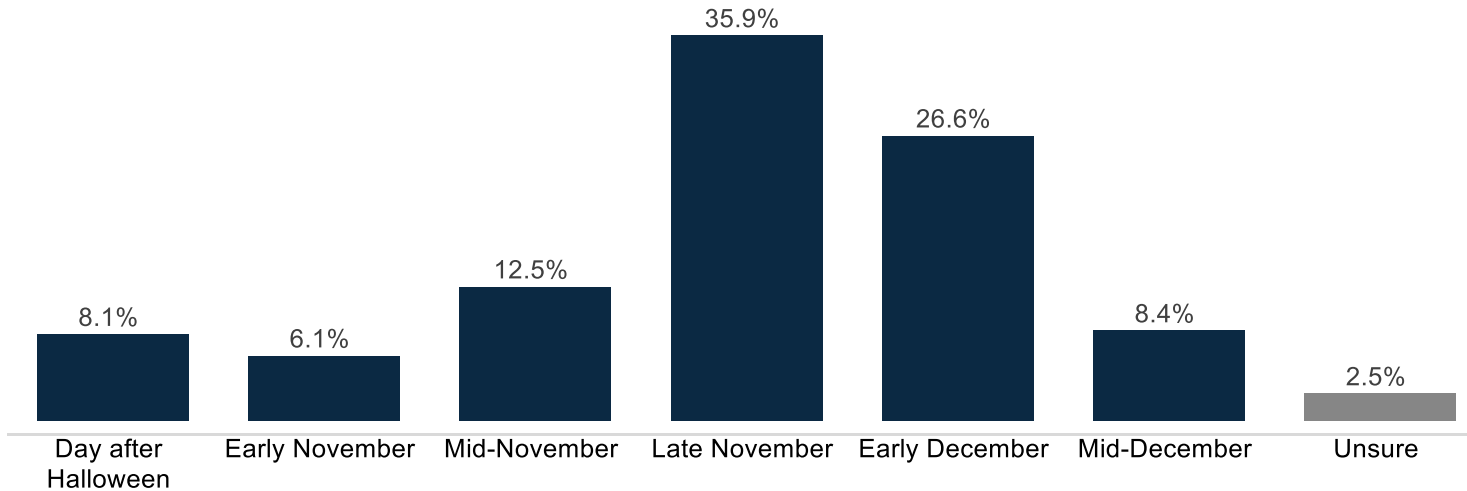

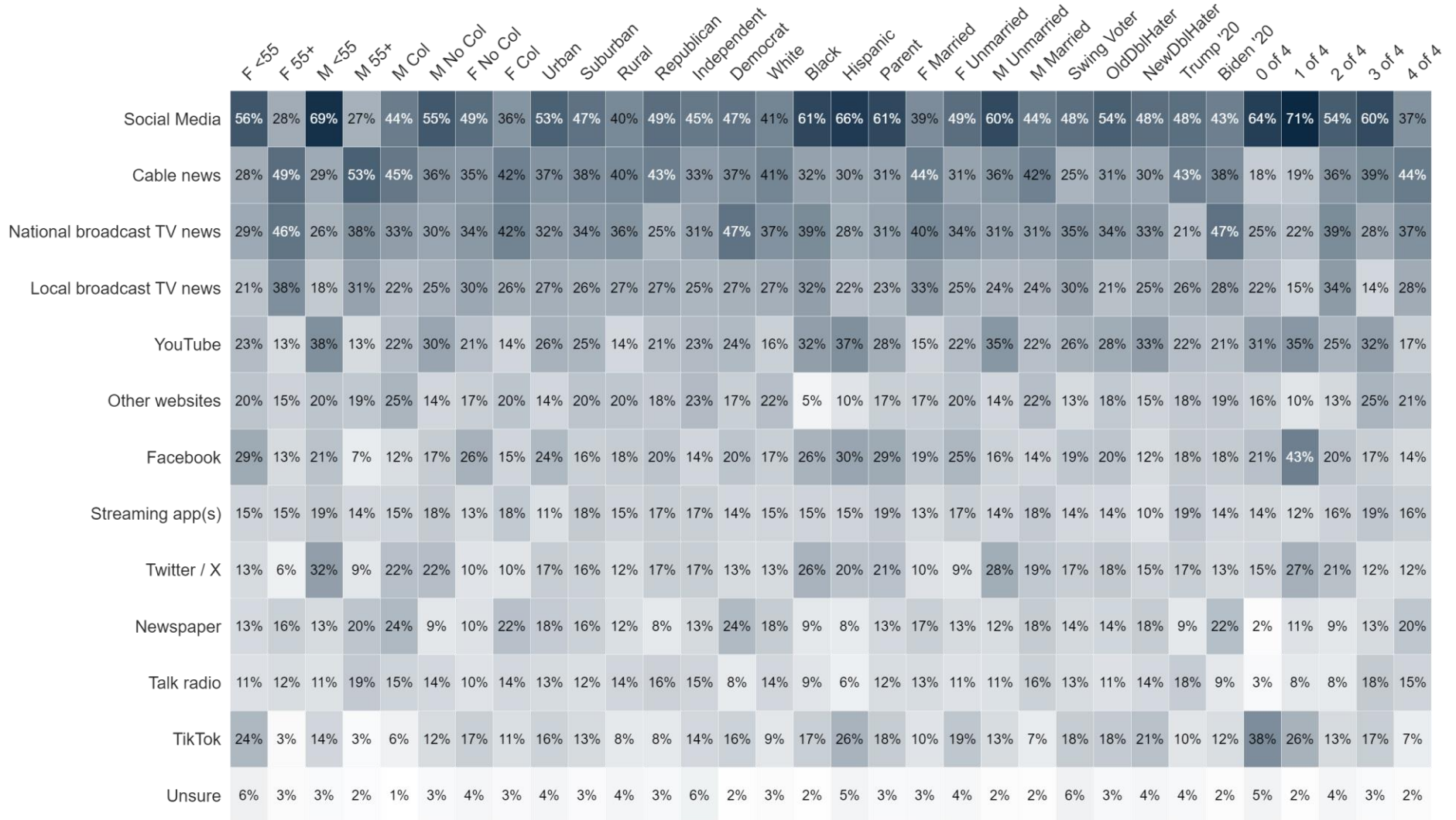
When do you think the Christmas season officially begins?

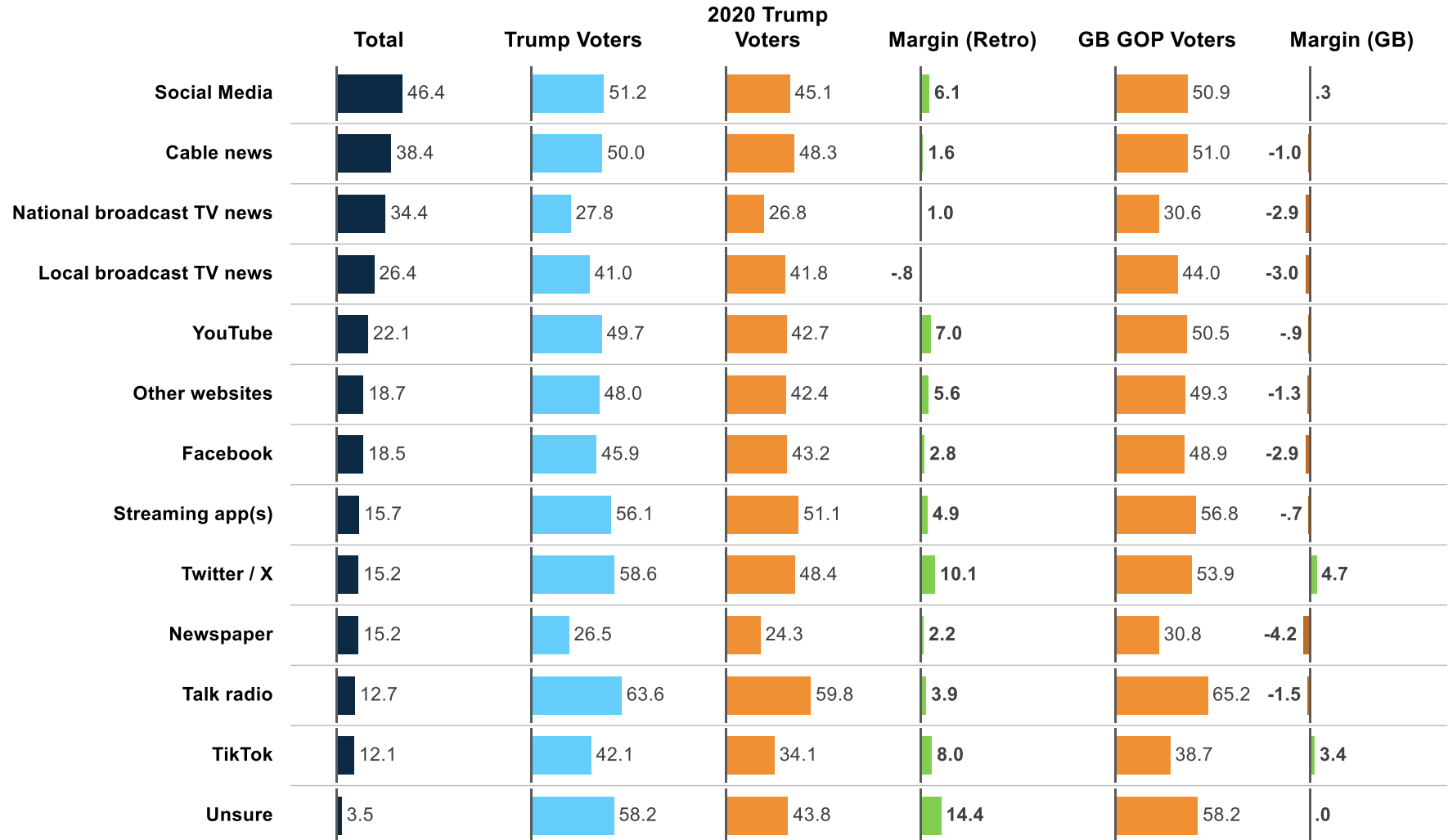
