
# Survey of Likely General Election Voters California Statewide

### **Insights & Analysis**

- The generic congressional ballot is D+22. The presidential race stands at 31% Donald Trump, 55% Kamala Harris, with 9% of voters choosing a third-party candidate and another 5% undecided (D+24). Undecideds on the presidential race are 40% R and 17% D on the generic.
  - **Donald Trump** is performing closer to his **2016** share (31.6%) than to his **2020** share (34.3%).
  - In contrast, Kamala Harris is underperforming both Biden's ballot share in 2020 (63.5%) and Clinton's ballot share in 2016 (61.7%), driven by the larger third-party vote share.
  - Though **Harris** is supported 2-to-1 by **Hispanic voters** (29–59) overall, **Trump** is overperforming with 29% of the Hispanic vote compared to the 23% he had based on 2020 exit polls. **Harris is underperforming** Biden's 75% support among Latino voters in 2020.
  - Harris's net image is +17 (57% fav / 40% unfav), making her much more favorable than Gavin Newsom (48% fav / 47% unfav).
- The U.S. Senate race stands at 32% Steve Garvey, 55% Adam Schiff, and 14% undecided (D+23), moving to D+24 when undecideds are matched up against their generic ballot partisan preference.
  - Harris' image is more favorable with undecideds and third-party U.S. Senate voters (56%) than Trump's (27%), who's image is similar to Garvey's among those groups.
- On **Proposition 33** (33 Yes, 48 No, 18 Undecided), a strong plurality of voters **oppose** repealing the Costa-Hawkins Act, effectively maintaining state restrictions on rent control policies.
- Machine-learning Segmentation Analysis identified three key voter segments: GOP Base (27%), Dem Base (56%), and Moderates (17%).
  - The Moderates segment is younger (<55), more college-educated, and more ideologically moderate than the GOP Base segment. They tend to be less informed about the candidates but lean heavily Republican on the generic ballot and Trump on the presidential. They are split right down the middle on Proposition 33 whereas the GOP Base is strongly opposed. They are more concentrated in the San Francisco/Sacramento DMAs than the GOP Base.</p>









### **Percent Change: Generic to Presidential Ballot**






### **U.S. Senate Ballot**









### Percent Change: Generic to U.S. Senate Ballot







### Methodology

This probabilistic survey was conducted October 27 - 30, 2024, in English, using registration-based sampling (RBS) techniques. A total of 611 respondents registered to vote in the State of California participated via SMS-to-web and live phone interviews. The survey has a margin of error of ±3.95% at the 95% confidence level.

Voter contact lists were sourced from Cygnal's proprietary voter file, which is regularly updated and maintained to reflect current voter registrations. The sample was stratified by geography (DMA groupings), registered political party, ethnicity, gender, and age to ensure representativeness. Each potential respondent was assigned a unique URL for survey entry through Qualtrics. Data quality protocols included checks for length of interview outliers, straightlining, duplicate IP addresses, and voter demographic consistency with the voter file.

The survey data were weighted to reflect the 2024 General Election Likely Voter population. Weighted variables include geography, gender, age, registered political party, race, and education. Population estimates for geography, gender, age, and political party were derived from Cygnal's proprietary voter file. Estimates for race and education were sourced from the 2022 American Community Survey and adjusted for a likely voter audience based on historical voting patterns and stated intent to vote.

Question wording on the toplines is consistent with the survey script and delivery in Qualtrics and by live interviewers. This survey was conducted internally by Cygnal's team and was not sponsored by any third party.
