She got her start with Speaker Mike Johnson, helping to deliver the House Majority in 2024. Additionally, she served in NRCC Deputy Chairman Brian Jack's office, overseeing communications and helping to drive political strategy in the 2026 cycle. She briefly left communications to serve in a political capacity at the National Republican Senatorial Committee, helping oversee the 33 Senate campaigns, including 8 key races in battleground states. A veteran of national and local communications planning, Abby currently serves as the Digital Communications Manager at Convergence Media where she works with U.S. House and Senate and gubernatorial campaigns. Alex Olson began his involvement in politics in high school and early college, volunteering on a multitude of campaigns in Idaho. He later served as the grassroots and youth engagement director for the Lieutenant Governor of Idaho's statewide campaign during the primary. Following their victory, he transitioned to the role of Deputy Chief of Staff for the Lieutenant Governor. At age 20, upon leaving that office, Olson founded his own consulting firm focused on legislative races, managing over a dozen campaigns in its first year. After a brief hiatus to contribute to Turning Point USA's Campus Victory Project, he returned to political consulting, serving as Vice President for Campaigns and later as CEO of Thomas Partners Strategies. In these roles, he managed and advised on campaigns ranging from U.S. Senate races to school board elections across the country, as well as ballot initiatives, political action committees, and corporate public relations efforts. Logan Gifford grew up in a broken home in East Las Vegas – his father never finished the eighth grade, his mother served time in Nevada state prison as a registered sex offender. He found his way out through education and civic engagement, beginning his political career at age 15 as an intern for Congressman Steven Horsford. Twelve years of bipartisan campaign experience followed. In 2024, as Executive Director of Repair The Vote PAC, he led Nevada's Voter ID constitutional amendment campaign – collecting more than 180,000 signatures across all 17 counties, defeating a legal challenge 7-0 at the Nevada Supreme Court, and winning Question 7 with 73% of the vote, a 50-point margin in a state decided by fewer than five at the top of the ticket. As Nevada Victory Regional Field Director in 2022, he helped drive 4 million voter contacts – the largest midterm field operation in state history. He serves as Nevada State Director for Our America and was elected in January 2026 as Clark County Republican Party Trustee for Commission District B. A public advocate for male survivors of childhood sexual abuse, his work has been featured in People, the New York Post, and the Las Vegas Review-Journal. A Freemason and Shriner, he lives in Las Vegas with his wife Tiffanie and their children.



Matt Hilton

Vice President of Paid Field Programs, Echo Canyon Consulting

Matt Hilton specializes in large scale, data driven door-to-door contact both in volunteer and paid efforts nationally. Namely working alongside Governor Abbott's re-election statewide paid field program where Matt's team knocked on over 3.4 million doors and provided an unparalleled level of quality data of 1.5 million voters. In 2024 his teams also worked on behalf of an independent expenditure supporting President Trump's re-election in Pennsylvania. Matt's team successfully executed a two month, 2.3 million door program helping flip the Keystone State. Since then, teams led by Matt have gone on to win a number of awards across the country for paid canvassing and AB/EV chase programs.
